## **Tournament Organisation and Rules**

The Monrad system is used to organise the games played in each round of the tournament. This means that every player will play a match in every round of the tournament - it is NOT a knock-out system. In each round you are playing for a ranking position, either to take the higher ranking off your opponent or to defend your higher ranking. At the end of the tournament, all players will have a final ranking/position.

1. The winner of each match **must** referee or find a person to referee the next game on that court,
2. Any player found not abiding by rule 1 will lose their £25 deposit,
3. No player will be allowed to switch grades once the tournament has commenced,
4. Players must be on the premises half an hour before their matches,
5. Tournament Referees decision is final.

## **Grades**

The University of Reading's Graded Tournament is a mixed event.

What grade am I ?

We are using the England Squash grading definitions :-

- A - players at county standard and playing at first or premier division level in a county league,
- B - a middle team player but not currently county standard,
- C - players who play regularly and are a 'lower' club team player,
- D - players who compete in an internal club league but have not represented a club team,
- U15 - under 15 years of age (as of 7<sup>th</sup> November 2005) and not wishing to play in the main graded events,
- U13 - under 13 years of age (as of 7<sup>th</sup> November 2005) and not wishing to play in the main graded events,

## **Prizes**

Yes, that's right, we have great prizes for each grade. First and second places in every grade will receive a trophy, as well as a cash prize for the top positions :-

A - £200.00, £100.00, £50.00, £25.00,

B - £100.00, £50.00, £25.00,

C - £50.00, £25.00,

D - £25.00, £10.00,

U15 - £40.00, £20.00,

U13 - £30.00, £15.00.

Every entrant will also receive a free 'tournament T-shirt', which although it may not be a prize, will be something you can keep to help you remember the fantastic time you had at the 8th Reading University Graded Squash Tournament.
